## The Importance of Charles Halloway in "Pursuits"

Charles Halloway becomes a major character in Part 2 of the novel. It is his bravery that saves Will and Jim several times from the evil of the carnival and Mr Dark, as well as the Dust Witch.

One of his acts of bravery for the boys is when he lies to Mr Dark about not knowing the boys names. He helps them escape from the situation completely when he blows smoke at the Dust Witch so she can't breathe- "...Will's father blew a dense cloud of cigar smoke. It made a fine thick cumulus surrounding the woman. `Gah!' she choked." (132) Then the woman runs off.
