Annual earnings in 2002 were \$30,180. The middle 50% earned between \$24,350 and \$37,520. The lowest 10% earned less than \$19,540, and the highest 10% earned more than \$45,570.

Some of the skills required to be a Substance Abuse and Behavior Disorder counselor include speaking, critical thinking, coordination, and active listening. People who are interested in being a counselor should have a strong interest in helping others and should possess the ability to inspire, respect, and trust.
