The two most important differences between Belize and Mexico are the language and the currency. About language, the official language in Belize is English, instead in Mexico is Spanish. With respect to the currency, the national currency from Belize is the Belizean Dollar and It from Mexico is the Mexican Peso. In addition, Belize has a several ethnic groups in contrast with Mexico.
