Essay

In the drama 'The Comedy of Errors', Shakespeare creates comic effects by introducing two sets of identical twins. They are Antipholus of Syracuse and Antipholus of Ephesus, Dromio of Ephesus and Dromio of Syracuse. These identical twins are separated and eventually met at Ephesus where they are mistakenly identified by the people and even each other. This confusion creates simultaneous comic effects to the characters and the book as a whole.

In Act 1 Scene 2, Antipholus of Syracuse asks Dromio of Syracuse to keep the money given from the merchant. He then went straight to the Centaur to keep it, "Go bear it to the Centaur where we host." Being mistakenly identifying S.A. (Antipholus of Syracuse) as his master, E.A. (Antipholus of Ephesus), E.D. (Dromio of Ephesus) went to fetch him to come to dinner. This incident got S.A. really angry. Due to this S.A. doubts about the money he asks him to keep and says, "Where is the money that I gave you?"
